



CLIENT DISCLAIMER

I confirm that I have seen and understood the safety video prior to riding.

1) I understand and accept that:

In participating in water sports activities that there is an element of danger and risk of injury to myself, which I undertake at my own risk; and in participating in water sports activities that there is an element of danger and risk of injury to others and consequently undertake to use the Company's equipment and facilities (the "Facilities") and to conduct myself while on the Company's premises in a sensible and responsible manner and in compliance with all notices, instructions and directions as published or displayed from time to time and in compliance with any instruction given to me by any authorized person in the Company's employment or control (an "Authorized Person"). I have read and acknowledge that conduct of the type set out in Section 3 below would amount to a breach of this paragraph.

2: I confirm that:

I will not use the Company's cable skiing facility without having attended a first timer's training session; and / or meeting the 'Minimum Standard' (as defined in Section 3 below);

I am in good state of health and free from any injury, medical condition, disease or illness which may be aggravated by participating in water sport activities or which may make it unsuitable for me to participate in such activities; and

I will not use the Company's Facilities while under the influence of any drugs or alcohol.

3: The minimum standard for Cable Ski use without qualified instruction is as follows:

- (a) The ability to swim 50m unassisted; and
- (b) The ability to complete one lap of the cable ski facility to the satisfaction of the person conducting the first timer's training session.

4: The following basic safety rules are drawn to the User's attention and in entering into this agreement the User agrees not to breach the same:

All Users MUST:

- (a) Let go of the handle when their path is obstructed
- (b) Avoid using the Facilities in a manner which might endanger other persons using the Facilities including skiing close to fallen skiers.
- (c) Exit the cable in the designated place - between the two orange buoys or such other place as may from time to time be designated.
- (d) Refrain from using the Facilities under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

- (e) Refrain from using ramps, sliders and kickers without the permission from the cable instructors.
- (f) Obey safety advice and signage and all instructions given to them by authorized personnel.
- (g) Refrain from instructing or attempting to instruct other users on the cable ski.
- (h) Treating the Company's property and the Facilities with respect and care.
- (i) This is not intended to be an exhaustive list of safety rules. The Company reserves the right to ask you to leave the Facilities without refund if you break any of the above mentioned rules or behave in a manner which in the opinion of the any authorized person represents a danger or potential danger to yourself or other Users.

5: I undertake to fully indemnify the Company, its directors, agents and employees against any claim brought by any third party for loss, damage, injury or death which has been caused by any action or omission of mine or any act or omission of any child of which I am the lawful parent or guardian or any child whose supervision is wholly or partly my responsibility at the time of the relevant act or omission that would if they had agreed to the same with full capacity to do so amount to a breach of these Terms and Conditions or which amounts to negligence or a willful act or omission.

6: I confirm that when accompanying a child or children I will comply and ensure that the child or children comply with the following:

- (a) General: All children under the age of 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult when on the Company's property. The adult must remain on the site for the duration of the child's visit and must supervise them appropriately at all times;
- (b) Changing Rooms: Young children up to 7 years may use either changing room under adult supervision. Children over 7 must use the male or female changing rooms appropriate to their gender; and
- (c) Children must be able to meet the Minimum Standard set out in Section 3 above after achieving a proficiency certificate issued by the Company. This certificate must be shown to the receptionist on any subsequent visits.

7: I understand that I need to arrive on site at least 30 minutes before the allotted time slot, and that failure to do so will result in the time slot being lost without compensation.
